

Redesign Update

From Library Director Tina Stewart:

We are excited to begin implementing our plans for the redesign of the first floor of the library at the end of May. This project was spearheaded with a \$100,000 grant award from the Cumminas Foundation. Additional funding support is being provided by the Barbara Johnson Trust Fund, Friends of the Library, the Town of Wilmington and state aid grants.



There will be some disruption of service while old shelving is removed, painting is done, and new carpeting, shelving, and furniture is installed.
